- Assist Fellowship Director and Program Manager with creation of program and marketing materials
- Work together with TAMID's student leadership who will be involved in all decision-making and implementation
- Other administrative responsibilities as assigned by Fellowship Director
- Take responsibility for any pre-program preparation ie. swag, apartment/housing preparations

- A self-starter with the ability to work independently
- Ability to anticipate, plan, and prioritize
- Experience working directly with highly-motivated undergraduate students (bonus)
- Demonstrated ability to establish and maintain strong relationships
- Proven to be goal-oriented, project-oriented and achievement-oriented
